

This prestigious regatta will welcome all metric and universal sailing classes this year. Notably, the 12 mJl yachts will compete in a race of the 56th Coupe de France du Yacht Club de France, marking the first Mediterranean stage of the 2024-2025 season. Additionally, the 2.4 mR class will hold a stage of their European circuit.

For the first time, a model yacht regatta featuring 1mJI IA and 2.7 Open IA will be organized under the patronage of the French Defense Procurement Agency (DGA). These model yachts will be on display in the Vieille Darse of Toulon's port, along the Cronstadt Quay, between the Town Hall and the Maritime Prefecture, from Thursday, May 22, to Sunday, May 25, accompanied by their many crew members.

The regatta will take place over four days in Toulon's Grande Rade and will be visible from the Vignettes Nautical Stadium. Spectators can follow the races both at sea and from land, with dedicated viewing options. Evening events will be held with the crews, and the yachts will be open for visits by reservation.

School groups and universities will take part in the event's organization and activities.

On Saturday, May 24, the public will be able to enjoy free sailing introductions and nautical activities in the Anse des Pins, within the Mourillon beaches.
